

# 1. Eligibility Criteria

Residency: Applicants must reside in Union or Anson County, North Carolina

**Academic Standing:** Applicants must be currently enrolled in high school, college, or university, with a minimum GPA of 2.0

Financial Need: Preference will be given to students demonstrating financial need.

#### 2. Application Requirements

To be considered for this scholarship, you must submit the following documents:

**Completed Application Form:** Ensure that all sections of the application form are filled out accurately and completely.

Academic Information: Include details such as your current school, expected graduation date, GPA, and intended major (if applicable).

**Family Information:** Provide information about your parents/guardians, household income, and number of siblings. If any siblings are currently enrolled in college, please mention this.

**Financial Need Explanation:** Describe why you need this scholarship, including details about your financial situation and any other scholarships or financial aid you are receiving.

**Extracurricular Activities and Honors:** List any church or extracurricular activities you are involved in, as well as any awards or honors you have received.

Personal Statement: Attach a 500-word essay addressing the following:

- Your educational and career goals.
- How you plan to achieve these goals.
- How this scholarship will impact your future.

## Additional Documents:

- High School or College Transcript.
- Letter of Recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or community leader.
- Proof of Enrollment or Acceptance Letter.
- Financial Aid Statement or FAFSA (if applicable).

## **3. Submission Guidelines**

- Deadline: Submit your completed application and all required documents by June 30, 2025.
